Student Representative

College and Career Readiness Report

Executive Director of Community Services Lisa Jacobs gave a presentation on College and Career Readiness. Early College presents great opportunities for our students. Mrs. Jacobs gave updates on the number of students who are involved in the Ferris State University Concurrent Enrollment partnership. Enrollment is currently at 239 students. Dual Enrollment offers 2 classes and has 20 students currently enrolled. 8 students are currently enrolled in Cloud Computing and Cybersecurity. Fall of 2022 will offer Dual Enrollment in Spanish. Eligible students will receive a 1,000 scholarship for all four years at FSU. We have also partnered with GVSU for AHS 100 Medical Terminology and AHS 110 Intro to Health Care. 21 students will take part in this program in the Fall of 2022. Tom Hosford spoke about how Lisa Jacobs is the go-to person and how she advocates for our students to have access to the many opportunities they do.

Staff Appreciation Resolutions

Korie Wilson-Crawford, Interim Superintendent, presented a resolution to the Board of Education establishing the week of May 2, 2022, as Staff Appreciation Week and Tuesday, May 3, 2022, as Staff Appreciation Day. New Business

1. Transportation Remodel – Phase I

Assistant Superintendent of Finance, Michael Cuneo presented financial information regarding the first phase of the transportation remodel. The bus garage is in need of upgrades. As part of the 2019 Bond Scope this project will be done. It will be a teardown and rebuild in phases. Shawn Hayward discussed the bids that were presented and explained the process including interviews and explained which bids were chosen. 2. Administrator Recommendation

This is a replacement position due to the retirement of Vic Villareal. Mr. Andrews recommended hiring Nicholas Davis to fill this position. His contract would start July 1, 2022. 2. Administrative Contract Renewals

The HR committee would look at increases and take them to the board. Motion passed unanimously. The Board is not expecting change but only to move forward. The board expressed how pleased they are with the Administrative team.
