Teya Cotter, Cannonsburg Elementary Principal updated the board on events happening at the

Elementary level.

Jenny Thompson from River Valley Academy gave a presentation about things happening at the Secondary Level.

3. Committee Reports – Tricia Anderson talked about the Building and Site committee meeting. Everything they met about has been presented at the meeting tonight. Christie Ramsey said the Curriculum committee met and discussed some exciting new Pilot programs coming soon.
4. Elementary Update – Dr. Matthews presented a recommendation to the Board of Education that would change the status of Parkside Elementary. This would not close the building but rather repurpose it allowing the district to service many families who have not been able to access pre-school programs in the past. This proposal will be presented for a vote at the March 10, 2025 meeting.
5. My Ride K-12 – Director of Transportation Matt Puett talked about the software program that Rockford is using called My Ride K-12. Parents are finding this app very useful for helping them with knowing when the bus is coming to pick up or drop off. It sends a notification if a bus is running late and also allows the district to send notifications to all signed up to receive them.

Superintendent Remarks

Dr. Matthews commented on the culture of Parkside and that the proposal is being brought forward because he believes it is in the best interest of the District. He will be meeting with parents over the next month and he knows it is important to continue to listen to parents and the community. It is important for us to continue to have this conversation. Parkside is a wonderful place for kids but we believe that a more robust experience we be a positive experience for them. Roguewood Elementary will continue to be both Spanish Immersion and General Education Classrooms. We all want what is best for the District and the students in our care. We are not hiding information. We are defending lawsuits that we feel need to be defended for our students and staff. He apologized for the emotion that this proposal has generated for families.

Subject: Outdoor Learning Program Expansion at Edgerton Trails Elementary

Dr. Matthews:

During the 2024-2025 school year, we established a district-wide elementary outdoor learning program. Starting outdoor learning in our district aligned with RAMS XII Academic Excellence Goal 1.D.2 - Innovative Programming. During the last seven months, students from all elementary schools have participated in a wide variety of outdoor learning experiences by traveling to Edgerton Trails or having Tara Dzirbowicz, the RPS Outdoor Learning Teacher, visit their building. Looking toward the 2025-2026 school year, there is opportunity to add to the district-wide programming by creating an outdoor learning classroom at Edgerton Trails for 4th grade students and, 4th and 5th grade for the 2026-2027 school year.

If approved, next year's outdoor learning-based 4th grade classroom would be led by a Rockford Public Schools teacher. The curriculum expectations would follow the same content standards as their grade level peers in traditional classrooms. However, the instructional delivery would be enhanced by outdoor learning experiences and connections. The program would be geared toward students who enjoy being outside and are inquisitive, self-directed learners.

Students participating in this classroom based programming will be determined by an application process, including student interviews and an eventual lottery. The application submissions and student interviews will take place in April, with the lottery and acceptance letter communications taking place in May.

The 4th grade outdoor learning students will remain in the program for fifth grade and transition to their geographically assigned middle school for 6th grade. Each year, we would add a new 4th grade class of students to Edgerton's Outdoor Learning classroom.

Enclosed, you will find additional information on the proposed classroom based Outdoor Learning Program, including an informational page to be posted on the website, the teacher referral form and the parent application.

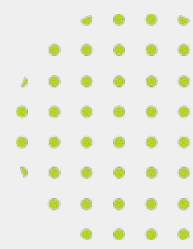

2025/26 Expansion Proposal

- Goal: by school year 26-27 have a Magnet Outdoor Education Program with a 4th and 5th grade. Students commit to participating for two years.
- School Year 25-26- Year 1
 - One Class of 4th Grade students admitted into the program
 - 1 classroom teacher
- School Year 26-27-Year 2
 - Inaugural Class moves to 5th grade
 - New 4th grade classroom of students enters
- Continued Outdoor learning opportunities for all RPS elementary students
 - Field trips to Edgerton Trails Elementary
 - Visits to the outdoor education spaces at each elementary school



Proposed Program Structure

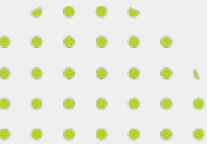
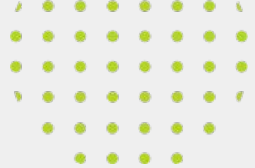

Rockford Public Schools is proud to announce a new outdoor learning program at Edgerton Trails Elementary for incoming 4th grade students in the district. The program will include all RPS curriculum components while incorporating project based learning in an outdoor setting. This unique opportunity is for students that enjoy being outside, are inquisitive and self directed learners. The program will be taught by a RPS certified staff member.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What grades are part of the outdoor learning program?

- Students will enter the program as 4th graders and spend two years in outdoor education. Moving to middle school in 6th grade.

Q: What is Outdoor Education?

- Outdoor education is a philosophy of embracing and experiencing the outdoors. Students participate in a variety of outdoor learning experiences while accessing the RPS curriculum.

Q: Where will the program be located?

- At Edgerton Trails Elementary School inside the school and at the Outdoor Learning property behind the school.

Q: What is the application and selection process:

- Students must be a current RPS student in the 3rd grade
- Interested families must fill out and complete an online application
- Classroom teachers will complete a recommendation form.
- Student interview
- Students that meet the criteria will be entered into the lottery

Q: How many students will be admitted?

- 26 students will be selected through a lottery system to be in the inaugural 4th grade class starting in the 2025-26 school year.

Q: Is there a waitlist?

- There will be a waitlist. If any of the 26 lottery students decline, the next student will be invited to enter the program.

Q: What is the curriculum?

- Students receive district aligned curriculum along with project based outdoor learning opportunities.

Q: How much time do students spend outside?

- This depends on a variety of factors. However, students will spend 50 - 70% of the school year outside.

Q: Does the district provide transportation to and from the Outdoor Education Program?

- TBD - A shuttle opportunity may be an option for students. Once a class list is developed the feasibility of assisting with transportation will be assessed.

Q: What happens in 5th grade?

- We plan to add a 5th grade section of outdoor learning in 2026 - 27. Students would remain with their peers and continue outdoor education for their fifth grade year. Students would transition to their assigned middle school in 6th grade.

Subject: Purchase of Student Furniture for ERMS and NRMS

Dr. Matthews,

It is spring and that means we are continuing to make progress at ordering classroom furniture for this summer's installation. As you recall, the furniture purchase is part of the 2019 Bond to enhance district learning environments and all elementary ordering is complete and we have moved onto both middle schools.

Last month, the proposed furniture budget for the core classrooms (math, ELA, science and social studies) at ERMS and NRMS was exclusive of the quote from Custer as it was not yet available. The Custer quote proposal for completing the core classroom furniture at both middle schools is \$342,803.36.

The second furniture budget proposal for the elective classrooms at ERMS and NRMS is \$594,204.52 and details are outlined in the attached packets. This includes furniture from Custer, Dew-El, VS and Architectural Systems Group.

In April, a second proposal will be submitted for the remaining elective classroom furniture at both middle schools for both middle schools from Interphase and Wenger. This timeline supports the summer installation schedule and will round out the complete order for both middle schools.

At Monday's meeting we will be seeking board approval of the budget to move forward. If you have any questions or require further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Subject: River Valley Academy Graduation Requirements

Dr. Matthews,

The Rockford Public Schools offers two high school programs, the traditional at Rockford High School, and an alternative pathway for students at River Valley Academy. The state of Michigan sets minimum high school graduation requirements (19.5 credits) through the Michigan Merit Curriculum and typically local school boards make additions. Graduation requirements for both RHS and RVA students are currently identical at 27.5 credits. The additional eight credits determined by our school board include elective courses and it is within our decision making to require these credits for every RPS graduate.

On Monday, March 10th, Director of River Valley Academy, Jenny Thompson, and I will be asking the RPS BOE to adopt a second graduation requirement pathway for only River Valley students that aligns with the Michigan Merit Curriculum credit requirements. Requiring fewer graduation requirements is a common practice and currently 76% (13/17) of neighboring districts have a second option for their alternative education students.

Students that choose to attend River Valley Academy are often credit deficient. Completing the additional elective credits as required by our one diploma for both high schools has both benefits and unintended consequences. Adding a second option for River Valley students that does not require eight elective credits will decrease students that need to be reclassified and/or those that are considering dropping out. The River Valley version of the MMD requirement would also include a career pathway elective experience.

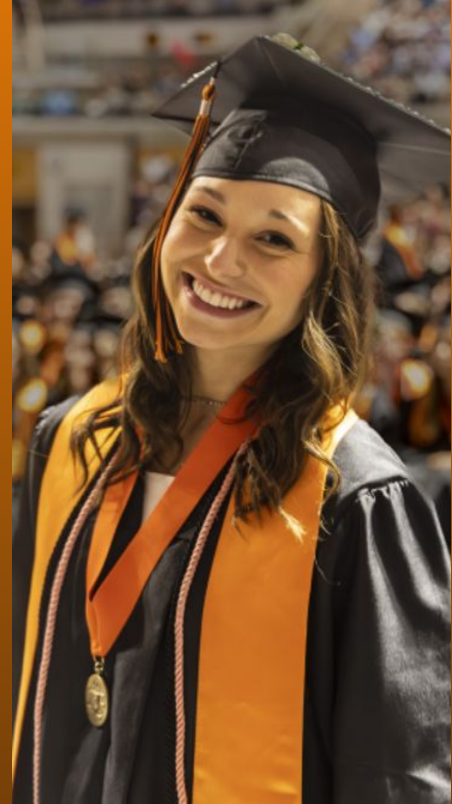

Value

A diploma is more than a piece of paper. Of course, a diploma provides **opportunity**, but it is also is a **rite of passage**. Our **Rockford Adult Education** experience has taught us that students without a diploma carry the weight of their failure to do so. Tears of relief are always a part of RAE graduation celebrations!

The GED is a path forward, but for many, earning a GED doesn't have the same impact as earning a diploma.

Subject: District Workstation Upgrade

The district regularly needs to replace and upgrade staff and student devices based on the useful life of the devices. This typically occurs every 4 years for Chromebooks, 5 years for Windows Laptop, and 7 years for desktops. Keeping with the Rams XII Pillar 5.C.2, Modernizing Infrastructure, the district continues to modernize the technology provided to staff and students. The district workstation upgrade also supports Rams XII Pillar 1.A.3 Student Engagement.

The project overview was presented to the Building and Site Committee on January 30 and the Finance Committee on February 19. Communication By Design received bids on March 5. Attached is the bid summary and motion of recommendation to approve the district workstation upgrades.

The bid summary will be presented to the Rockford Board of Education on Monday, March 10, 2025. The recommendation is to approve the bid package from CDW-G LLC in the amount of \$2,062,861.20, to be paid out of proceeds of the 2019 bond.
